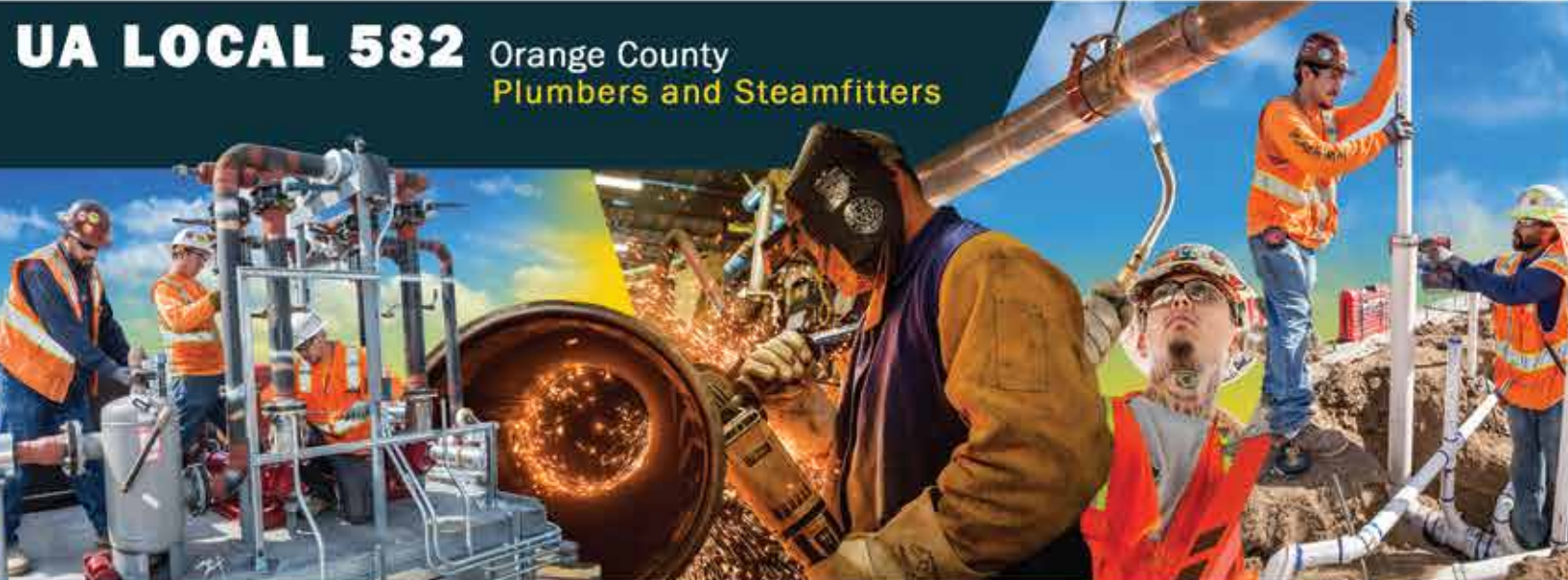
Our raises went into effect September 1, 2021 so hopefully you all received those. If not, please call your business agents right away.

On Friday, July 9, 2021 at the LiUNA Local 652 hall in Santa Ana, Representative Katie Porter (US Congress) held a meet and greet along with some Q&A with US Labor Secretary Marty Walsh. Secretary Walsh was sworn in as the 29th Secretary of Labor for the Biden Administration and he leads the US Department of Labor with a strong connection to the working-class people.

Secretary Walsh spent the last 7 years as Mayor of Boston, and as mayor he led the creation of close to 140,000 jobs, paid sick leave and paid personal leave. The Secretary is very close to Labor, as he followed his Father’s footsteps into Laborers Local 233 in Boston and rose to the Head of the Building & Construction Trades Council from 2011 to 2013.

Secretary Walsh is Labor friendly and has vowed to the Building Trades Council that he will support CWA’s and PLA’s for the Union Trades, and with this new Infrastructure Bill approved through bipartisan politics, he will make sure that the Skilled and Trained Union Trades will benefit from the most. This is the first time in many years that the Building Trades has had a Labor friendly Secretary of Labor.

Cal State University Fullerton Student Housing



The Cal State University Fullerton Student Housing job will consist of three building structures (all poured in place concrete). They are currently averaging a concrete pour a week between the three structures. This job is really moving fast and according to A.O. Reed's Pipe Fitting General Foreman Tom Leonardo and Plumbing GF William Snowden. The CSUF Student Housing structures are 6 stories each plus a roof. There will be approximately a total of 75 rooms with 8 students per room for a total of 600 beds. AO Reed's Tom Leonardo says that they will pick out at a total of 9 men for the Pipe Fitters side of work and William Snowden thinks they will pick out at a total of 13 Plumbers. This job is 100% prefabricated from the shop and delivered to the site. Sundt is the General Contractor and they are based out of Phoenix Az and according to both Tom and William, have been great to work for and understand and know how to build. The completion date for this job is to be August of 2022.

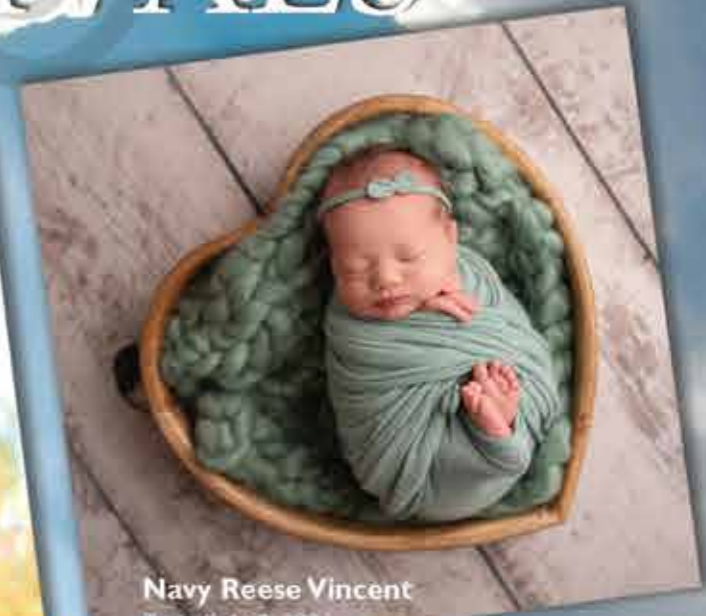

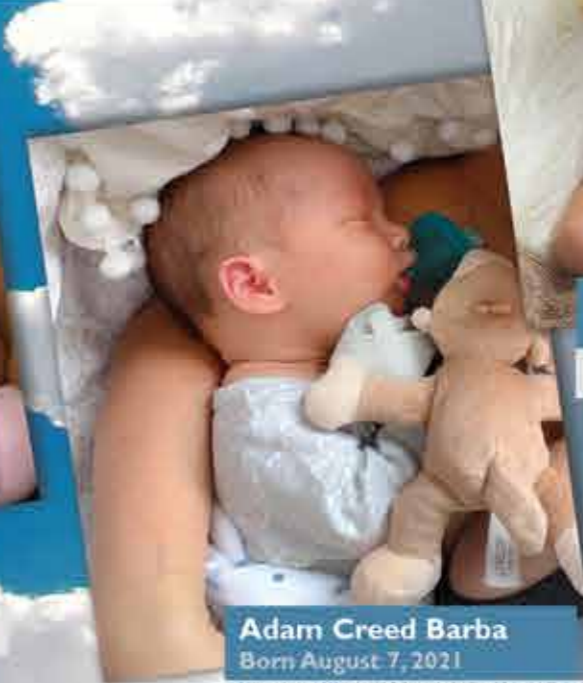
